There is a deck of 55 cards:

A E I O x 5. N R S T x 3. B C D L M P x 2. F G H K V W J Q U X Y Z x 1. Joker x 1. And a set of dice.

To start the game, each player rolls the dice and the player with the highest number goes first and then each player goes clockwise. Whatever is thrown, a four or an eight, that amount of cards is received and the player tries to construct a word with the number displayed on the dice, ie. For example, if a six letter word is required, two three letter words, a five and a one letter word, a four and two letter word or a one and six letter word may be constructed.

Should a word or words in the amount thrown be accomplished, two points are had for every letter used to create total word or words demanded, ie. A four letter word created, eight points are had.

When an eight letter word or more is demanded and made, a bonus is had.

Eight letter words, 20 pts. Nine letter words, 25 pts. 10 letter words, 30 pts.

11 letter words, 40 pts. 12 letter words, 50 pts.

Should a player create size of word shown on dice, player throws dice again and goes.

When finished, Player then adds cards to deck which is reshuffled and the next player rolls the dice and plays.

The first one to reach a100 points wins.
