CUT: The RAINDROP looking at a deserted Earth. 3

RAINDROP

What is this place and what will happen to me and what am I supposed to do here? Boy, it's so quiet and where are all the other raindrops? Whenever I fall anywhere, like Mars or that planet around Alpha Centuri there are always millions of us. Where is everybody? HELLO, is anybody here? Now that I have arms, I wish I had legs, and then maybe I would find someone to talk to and play with? What about music? I feel like dancing, but how can I dance without music? Wait a second, could this be some kind of trick? I bet all those raindrops will show up in a minute like they always do and plop all over. I love to plop with them, its fun. ELIJAH laughs and tickles the raindrop in his hand as he enters school. 11

CUT: The RAINDROP talking aloud as it hears a bee buzzing: 12

RAINDROP

Hey, it was so quiet and peaceful and now, what's all that bzzz I hear? I hear bzzz again and again. Who's making all that bzzz? Will you cut it out; will you cut that bzzz out please? It's annoying and it's getting louder and louder! And, I don't believe it, that bzzz has some nerve, 'cause

he just landed right on me without even saying may I? and its poking its nose in me

and its pointy, that bzzz's nose is real pointy, and it doesn't hurt, in fact I think I like it, yeah, I like it, 'cause it feels good, real good. Hey, maybe I should ask that lazy lucky old sun when I see him what this bzzz is doing, poking his nose in me? I will,

ROSE

(Whines.)

SUN

ROSE

SUN

GOAT

(Whinnies.)

(Chants.)

you're afraid, Mr. Cheetah is afraid!

Mr. CHIMP

Do you think I'm afraid of that loud-mouth lion, Miss?

ROSE

I've never met Mr. Lion. So I don't know why Elsie, Billy and Trigger were so afraid that they ran away? I'm not afraid Maybe his bark is worst than his bite?

(Roars.)
